We also are committed to keeping the cost of a Religious School education affordable, so we have only increased tuition by approximately 4%, in line with the rate of inflation. The basic Religious School tuition that CBB members pay covers only a portion of CBB's actual cost for each student. This year we are again providing the option of voluntarily electing to pay CBB's "Actual Cost" of providing your child's Jewish school education. Any amount you choose to pay above the basic Member Rate may be a tax-deductible contribution. Please consult your tax professional for confirmation.

The CBB leadership feels that educating our children is so important that it is policy to admit all members' children, regardless of ability to pay. The attached form provides a space for you to mark to let us know if you need financial assistance for all or part of your tuition. A confidential and caring process will carefully consider all applications.
