

WHAT'S HAPPENING IN ISRAEL AND THE MIDDLE EAST?



A 4-session mini-course led by **Rabbi Ira Youdovin** 7:30-9:00 pm January 8, 15, 22 and 29

The specific topics to be discussed at each session will be announced in CBB's weekly email.

The past year has seen a miasma of activity both inside Israel and throughout the Middle East, with repercussions in Washington, Moscow, London, the United Nations and elsewhere. Israeli national elections are scheduled for January 22. We will know the results when we meet that evening and will be able to speculate on what lies ahead.

Rabbi Ira Youdovin, a CBB member, is Executive Vice President Emeritus of the Chicago Board of Rabbis, and founding director of ARZA---Association of Reform Zionists of America (the Zionist arm of the Union for Reform Judaism). He currently chairs the Jewish Community Relations Committee of the Santa Barbara Jewish Federation, and is a member of the Santa Barbara Israel Task Force. He serves on the national board of the Jewish Council of Public Affairs chairing its Committee on International Jewry. He participates in JCPA's Leadership Mission to Israel in mid-December, and will include impressions and information garnered from meetings with top Israeli and Palestinian leaders in class discussions.
