Candle-lighting (Cantor's CD Track 2)

(prepare by taking a moment to think of those you love)

(prepare by taking a moment to picture the world as it was immediately after the creation; the first Sabbath--the world whole and at peace)

Blessing the Challah (Cantor's CD Track 4)
