Rabbi Gutow is recognized as one of the nation's most influential rabbis by Newsweek and as one of the nation's top Jewish leaders by the Forward. JCPA is an advocate of a strong U.S.-Israel relationship. Its domestic programs include: Fighting Poverty with Faith and Coalition on the Environment and Jewish Life.

Daniel Matt is one of the world's leading authorities on Kabbalah. He has published over ten books, including The Essential Kabbalah and Zohar: Annotated and Explained. Daniel is currently translating and annotating the Zohar, the masterpiece of Kabbalah. For this work. Daniel has been honored with a National Jewish Book Award and a Koret Jewish Book Award. The Koret award called his translation "a monumental contribution to the history of Jewish thought." Dr. Matt has been featured in Time Magazine, and has appeared on National Public Radio and the History Channel. For twenty years, he served as professor at the Graduate Theological Union in Berkeley, California, and has also taught at Stanford University and the Hebrew University of Jerusalem.
